Who Lives Here?

The children will read the eBook Who Lives Here?, linking the text to their own experiences. They use maps to recall the sequence and ask questions about events in the eBook. They learn about different uses for capital letters and use these in their writing. The writing tasks involve composing factual sentences about animals and writing a nature diary following a model.

Sensational Senses

They will use their senses to explore the weather, mud and the playground as they enjoy listening to a range of poetry. They come up with new vocabulary and sound effects and use real and invented words to describe what they feel - linking it all to their own experiences. They construct sentences to describe how things feel and sound.

Word Detectives

Children take on the role of word detectives to investigate spelling patterns and generate their own spelling rules.

Geography

Colour Creations

We will think about their favourite colours and the colours that are all around them every day, They will learn about primary colours, secondary colours, colour mixing, and light and shade, as well as look at the artwork of artists who use colours in interesting ways, namely Kandinsky and Mondrian.

Flying Kites

In D.T will teach your children how to test different materials, design kites, construct a carp kite and a diamond kite, fly kites and evaluate their own creations.

PSHCE

Diverse Britain (Being British)

The children will learn that they belong to different groups and communities such as family and school. We will also explore how they can contribute to the life of the classroom, school and community around us.

Relationships

In this unit, children will learn about the importance of being kind to others, The effects of bullying and teasing and what to do about it if they see it happening to others or if it happens to them. We will also explore how to identify good and not so good choices.

Computing

Basic computer skills

In this unit children will learn how to turn on a computer, open an application, mouse and keyboard skills, type letters and symbols, draw different shapes using paint software, use a brush in a paint application and change the size and colour,

Online Safety

They will recall some of the SMART rules for Internet safety, know who to tell if someone online asks for personal information, understand why email is a good way to communicate, choose the correct Safe Search filter when using a search engine; make links between the online and offline world, recognise which personal information they should keep safe from strangers.
